### *Get Bold – Break Out*

Americans think they are free, but they are really not. They are in slavery to the world system. They are deceived. Jesus says in John 8:32, *“And ye shall know the truth, and the truth shall make you free.”* Notice the word “make.” The Word doesn't simply let someone be free or set someone free, but rather the Word makes you free. The word “make” has the implication of power. Only God's power can destroy mental and spiritual bondages and free the captives.

In verse 33 we can see how deception can have such a strong foothold. *“They answered him, We be Abraham's seed, and were never in bondage to any man; how sayest thou, Ye shall be free?”* How could they be under Roman occupation and think they were not in bondage?

The Jews under Roman occupation who argued they were never in bondage are similar to Americans today who argue

that they are not in bondage, but free. America was dedicated to be part of God's system, yet because so many people have been under the inferior world system for so long, they can not perceive that they are in bondage to a fear-based system under the influence of demonic principalities.

Did you ever think you were in truth and yet, later, found out you had been deceived? You were not lying, but simply deceived. There was a time when I got caught up in Transcendental Meditation (TM) and told people how great it was. I was not deliberately lying, but was speaking from my deception. I did not perceive that I, as a Baptist, was a practicing Hindu at the same time. The TM people did not tell me that I was engaging in Hindu practices, or that the mantra they gave me was the name of a Hindu god. In fact, they called it a science, and I believed a lie. However, Jesus said in Matthew 24:4, *“Take heed that no man deceive you.”* You can die believing a lie.

Today, people think they are doing right, based on their intellect. However, they are missing the revelation of God's truth. Before the fall, Adam operated primarily by revelation, and not by intellect; and so should we. Let us examine the truth of kingdom of God realities, today.

Jesus tells us in Mark 1:15, "...*The time is fulfilled, and the kingdom of God is at hand: repent ye, and believe the gospel.*" The word repent starts with the prefix "re" that denotes to return, restore, or bring back. The word "repent" in this verse in the Greek root means to think differently (i.e., reconsider (feel compunction)). Jesus brought back the kingdom of God realities that Adam and Eve lived in before the fall. Now we have to realize that we are as they were at the beginning of man, living in the image and likeness of God. This is the time spoken of in Joel 2:23-25, "*Be glad then, ye children of Zion, and rejoice in the Lord your God: for he hath given you the former rain moderately, and he will cause to come down for you the rain, the former rain, and the latter rain in the first month. And the floors shall be full of wheat, and the vats shall overflow with wine and oil. And I will restore to you the years that the locust hath eaten....*" We now receive the former rain and the latter rain, and God will restore the years the locust has eaten. We see great overflow and restoration all the way back to Adam for things that were lost. God always brings back more than before, just like he gave Job twice as much as he held prior to his ordeal. Jesus is telling us in Mark 1:15, "*time is fulfilled*" and it is time now for the kingdom to be manifested on this planet by us, empowered by God. Jesus tells us that now, "...*the kingdom of God is within you.*" (Luke 17:21) It is not going to be. It is.

God wants to show the world His love and that He is God, and it is upon us to demonstrate the power of God. He will lead us to do things we can not do, to engage in battles we can not win. But He does these things and wins these battles through us. The challenge we must engage in is re-programming our minds to get heaven in, and get the world system out. We must walk in the Word of God. We must renew our minds to who God says we are, to what God says we have, and to what God says we can do. It is time to get bold and break out. As Jesus tells us in Mark 9:23, "...*If thou canst believe, all things are possible to him that believeth.*"

We must get the proper mindset of being born of God. Our image has to be correct, so let us look at that. Did you ever notice how often in the Bible, God refers to seed? We have to realize that the natural exists to teach us about the spiritual; and yet for the natural to exist it had to first be spiritual because before there was anything natural, God was and is Spirit. So it is totally natural for you to operate in the spiritual realm.

Going back to the study of seed for a moment, in Genesis 1:11-12 (Amplified Bible), we see an interesting foreshadow for today. In verse 11, referring to vegetation, plants, and fruit bearing trees; God said "...*yielding fruit each according to its kind, whose seed is in itself....*" Then in verse 12, the Word says, "...*yielding seed according to their own kind and trees bearing fruit in which was their seed, each according to its kind....*" Note there are three references in two verses of yielding according to its kind. When God repeats Himself like that He is emphasizing a point, often one that we have overlooked in the past. Here we see God referring to

the natural world and how fruit yields according to its kind from a seed that is in itself. Thus, we see plants yielding seed, according to their own kind, and trees bearing fruit wherein lies their seed, according to its kind.

Now look at the supernatural correlation. In 1 Peter 1:23, we see a description of us as, *“Being born again not of corruptible seed, but of incorruptible, by the word of God, which liveth and abideth forever.”* Yes, we are born of incorruptible seed, by the Word of God, and yield incorruptible fruit, according to its own kind, from the incorruptible seed within us; yielding seed, according to its own kind, and fruit bearing trees in which is the incorruptible seed to produce ever more fruit; which in turn yields ever more seed, after His kind, and fruit bearing trees in which lies the incorruptible seed thereby continuing to grow the Garden of God’s glory.

The devil’s corrupt seed can’t begin to reproduce the harvest of God’s incorruptible seed growing ever greater fruit bearing trees with His seed in kind to produce ever more. As God first started to prepare the Garden of Eden and unleash his love and glory throughout the world, we see a foreshadowing of how the incorruptible seed today will expand the kingdom of God throughout the world.

Our answer is not in the world, not in the political system, although we will impact those systems; our answer and power is in the Word and in that God’s power. The incorruptible seed is in us; and we bear fruit and seed, from within us, of the incorruptible seed, as we walk in God’s plan to extend His kingdom of love, grace, and mercy throughout the Earth.

Now if we go to John 1:1, we learn, *“In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God.”* Jesus was the Word walking with flesh and bones. Now, we are God’s incorruptible seed and that puts us born again people in the supernatural category of being the Word with flesh wrapped around it. When you lay hands on someone, the Word is laying hands on them. When you pray for someone, the Word is praying for them.

The world tries to tell people that they are just animals – perhaps on a higher evolutionary plane, but animals nevertheless. Hogwash. For believers, you are born again of God’s incorruptible seed and have kingdom of God realities living in you. Spiritually, as a born again Christian, you are on the same level as Adam before the fall. You have total access to walk and talk with God. For non-believers, you have the potential for all of that in you, just awaiting your choice to come to the Lord. All of us are created in the image and likeness of God, and wired for dominion and authority.

In Matthew 12:33-37, God speaks of good and corrupt fruit. In verse 33, Jesus said, *“Either make the tree good and his fruit good; or else make the tree corrupt, and his fruit corrupt: for the tree is known by his fruit.”* Notice we do not live in the Garden of Eden anymore. The fruit is in us. Now, praise God the Garden is in us, and, *“...out of the abundance of the heart the mouth speaketh.”* (verse 34) We are justified by words or condemned by words. I am talking about living from the inside out rather than the outside in. God wants you to flow in revelation knowledge and establish a foundation within your spirit that cannot be shaken.

The chief strategy of Satan is to keep us in the past. But, we have been born again of incorruptible seed and what is past is literally gone. You do not look at someone's history from before their birth, so get real with who you are today. You are as the apostle Paul, an ambassador (Ephesians 6:20) for the kingdom of God. An ambassador does not speak the words they think; an ambassador speaks the words of his government. We are tutored by the Holy Spirit and taught to think like God, believe like God, take authority like God, and speak like God. All this comes out of the heart of man.

This requires moving the boundaries of our heart. Let us take a farmer for an example. A farmer's harvest is limited by the amount of land he plows. I recall as a young child watching my uncle drive his tractor to the fence line and turning it around to do the next row. There were fences. He could not exceed those fences in his life.

Now, God is telling us to keep plowing, not to stop at the internal fence lines, to just keep going. God knows that those internal fences are limitations in our hearts that He did not erect. As we allow God to sanctify our core belief pattern, we begin to realize we have no internal fences to hold us back, that we can keep plowing. By trying to do things in our own power, we are the ones who limit ourselves with internal fences that were never intended to be there. We need to plow through the fences in our heart and reset the boundaries.

We need to have today's good report like Joshua and Caleb did in their time. They preached, "...*Let us go up at once, and possess it; for we are well able to overcome it.*" (Numbers 13:30) We

have to preach what is impossible to man, or it is not of God. Most preachers today are just like the 10 spies who came back and, speaking out of what they could perceive in their natural mind, viewed themselves as grasshoppers, but the Word says they gave an evil report (Numbers 13:32-33). The devil wants you to have a distorted self-view. You need the right picture inside you to see and judge correctly. If you are speaking out of your natural mind then you are carnal, and not living in the image and likeness of God. It is time for a higher living.

Proverbs 4:23 tells us that out of the heart "*...are the issues of life...*" Whatever is in your spirit is manifested in your life. We see what is inside by what is outside. You know the tree by its fruit. In your life, look at the fruit, because it points to the roots. 3 John 2 tells us to "*...prosper and be in health even as thy soul prospers.*" You need to stop identifying with the world and start identifying with Jesus; and His call to live in the likeness and image of God, to be fruitful and fill the earth with God's love and glory. Real dominion comes from your spirit, not your flesh.

To live in the spirit realm and have kingdom of God realities manifested daily in your life, you have to live in the Word of God. This will enable you to exercise your faith first in your mouth, and then in your heart as spoken of in Romans 10:8, "*The word is nigh thee, even in thy mouth, and in thy heart: that is, the word of faith, which we preach.*" When you have the Word in your eyes, ears, and heart you can take God literally at His Word. As we are told in Joshua 1:8, "*This book of the law shall not depart out of thy mouth; but thou shalt meditate therein day and night to do all*

*according to all that is written therein: for then thou shalt have good success.”* Note the four steps here. First, speak the Word from your mouth continually. Second, meditate upon the Word of God day and night. As you do this, the Lord will give you a verse or verses that will become real to you, as you receive the revelation of that scripture in your life. As you meditate, the incorruptible seed from the Word of God starts growing a strong tree inside you, and the manifestation you are looking for comes out of the fruit of that tree of faith. It will require turning off the television set, since the bulk of television programming is a product of the world’s system that helped deceive you in the first place. Third, do what the Word says to do. Doing is important because step four is the result of doing the first three steps: you will make your way prosperous and have good success. God has given you revelation knowledge of His Word and empowered you to walk in His authority. You make your way successful by doing the Lord’s will.

The process goes from meditation of the Word, to revelation of the Word, to application of the Word, to manifestation of the Word. As we see in John 17:19, you are, “...*sanctified through the truth.*” As you get truth, trust the truth, and do the truth; you become more sanctified from the world. This will manifest in every area of your life. Some may say you are getting materialism, but rather you are just getting manifestation.

The importance of getting the Word into the heart and speaking it is seen in Romans 10:8-10, “...*The word is nigh thee, even in thy mouth, and in thy heart: that is, the word of faith, which we preach; That if thou shalt confess*

*with thy mouth that God hath raised him from the dead, thou shalt be saved. For with the heart man believeth unto righteousness; and with the mouth confession is made unto salvation.”* You will find it easier to believe with your heart than with your mind. Notice the heart (spirit) believes. Your spirit accepts the Word as truth and then you must speak it out. At the same time, realize the mind is the seat of reason, the old self; and reason tries to dissuade your belief in the Word. But, we need to change from a faulty self-image to a Word-based self-image. The gates of hell will prevail against you until you receive the revelation of God’s truth.

God has given us the means to succeed, ordaining it before the foundation of the world. In Ephesians 1:3,4 we are told, “*Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, who hath blessed us with all spiritual blessings in heavenly places in Christ: According as he hath chosen us in him before the foundation of the world, that we should be holy and without blame before him in love.*” He placed within you the anointing that will empower you to fully succeed beyond your imagination. Also, He chose you before the foundation of the world, before Lucifer and before sin existed; He chose you. Everything is already there – love, wisdom, peace, health, money, joy. Heaven is not broke, sick, or sad. It is a healthy, wealthy place and God wants you to show people the kingdom of God.

In Luke 5:1-7 we see where people pressed upon Jesus to hear the Word. Jesus saw two ships and asked Peter if He could go out a little from land so He could teach the people. Peter complied. After Jesus finished teaching, Jesus told Peter to launch out and let down his nets. In verse 5, Peter replied, “*Master, we*

*have toiled all night, and have taken nothing: nevertheless at thy word I will let down the net.*” Now this is huge. In the Greek, the term “word” used in verse 1 is logos. However, after hearing the Word of God, in verse 5, when Peter says, “*at thy word,*” that term in the Greek is the rhema. Peter now has the revealed Word of God and even then only partially obeyed initially. Jesus told Peter in verse 4 to “let down your nets (plural). We see in verse 5, Peter let down a net (singular). Of course then after the net broke because there were so many fish, Peter called for the other ship, and both ships caught so many fish that they began to sink. Peter moved out from the world’s system to God’s system. When you act on the rhema, the revealed Word of God, you get results.

Remember, God does not see you as an old sinner. He sees you as blessed before the foundation of the world. When you accepted Christ, your spirit was recreated to line up with His total will and blessing for you.

In addition to all spiritual blessings that come through Jesus, you also have the blessings of Abraham. In Romans 4:13, we see, “*For the promise, that he should be the heir of the world, was not to Abraham, or to his seed, through the law, but through the righteousness of faith.*” Abraham didn’t get the blessings because of obedience to the law, but by his faith. Note in this verse the reference to you, “*or to his seed.*” You receive the blessing of Abraham by your faith. Abraham’s blessing was cattle, silver, and gold (Genesis 13:2). The blessing we have through Abraham is a physical, rather than spiritual, blessing because Abraham was not born again. All spiritual blessings come through Jesus.

All this connects to 3 John 2, “*Beloved I wish above all things that thou mayest prosper and be in health, even as thy soul prospereth.*” You will never prosper in any area beyond the condition of your soul. To prosper your soul you have to spend time meditating the Word and in prayer, providing an avenue for truth to reshape the self-image in your soul.

Let us repent for not demonstrating the kingdom of God in power, truth, and reality so Americans and the world would know there is indeed a difference between the kingdom of God, and the religions of the devil and man. Let us earnestly seek the kingdom of God and demonstrate it by power; and let us thank God for forgiving us and revealing to us true kingdom realities. Then we can walk in those realities, expanding the kingdom on earth.

Americans need to hear and see the truth inwardly in their spirit; and outwardly by demonstrations of God’s power, because they are enslaved in the world’s system. They are at a point that says, show me and I’ll believe it. A mature Christian accepts the truth of the Word in their spirit, but carnal Christians and the unsaved need outward demonstrations of power. This is the crux for CFAR and the Christian church, because the church body needs to live in kingdom of God realities before restoring America. Praise God, the apostle Paul tells us in 1 Corinthians 4:20, “*For the kingdom of God is not in word, but in power.*” It is time. Get bold in kingdom realities and break out of the world system.
