Boldly Walking from the World into Kingdom Realities

Continuing the theme from the last newsletter, we must leave the world's system and live in the kingdom of God before we retake America. This teaching is vital because weak people don't retake nations. Strong people do. As we are taught in Joel 3:10, "...let the weak say, I am strong."

America Reclaimed Ministries is not developing a carnal program to deal with a carnal problem. What we are doing is applying kingdom of God truths to confront the world and reclaim America's Christian heritage and destiny.

With that introduction we see in Romans 10:10, "*For with the heart man believeth unto righteousness; and with the mouth confession is made unto salvation.*" Notice Paul is teaching here, and says

it's with the heart that man believes. It is important to know that it is easier to believe the things of God in our heart than in our mind. Notice also, we have to confess with our mouth. It is not good enough just to believe something in our heart. We have to confess it verbally with our mouth.

In Mark 9:17-18, we see where a man took his son who had a dumb spirit to Jesus' disciples and they couldn't cast out the demon. His son still could not speak. Then if we go down to verse 23 we see Jesus said, "*If thou canst believe, all things are possible to him that believeth.*" Now we have been trained by the world not to go further than others, but you are unique, i.e., fingerprints, eye scan, etc. There are things for you to do in God that others have not been called. Your current beliefs came from listening to friends, your history, teaching, etc. But God said if you can believe, **all** things are possible (Mark 9:23).

Similarly, in Psalm 103:19 we see that, "*The Lord hath prepared his throne in the heavens; and his kingdom ruleth*

over all.” The Kingdom of God reigns over everything. It does not matter what people think. Jesus is Lord of all, and His kingdom reigns over all.

Based on the Word and not what others say, we saw in Romans 10:10 that with the heart, man believes. God speaks to your heart. In Romans 10:11-12, we also see, *“For the scripture saith, whosoever believeth on him shall not be ashamed. For there is no difference between the Jew and the Greek: for the same Lord of all is rich unto all that call upon him.”* You can not say the Lord won’t work with you. You simply have to do it His way if you want His blessings.

Let us look at Acts 10:34. *“Then Peter opened his mouth, and said, “Of a truth I perceive that God is no respecter of persons.”* Stop thinking that somehow you are so different that God’s Word won’t work for you. You are made in the image and likeness of God and it is time to stop believing the lie of the devil, the deception of the world, and see yourself for who you really are, the righteousness of God in Christ, and it is time for demons to start trembling when you walk in the room, because the devils also believe, and tremble (James 2:19). Put them in their stinky low place. Tell the devil if he wants to speak to you, put a sticky note on the bottom of your shoe. Because that’s his true position, as the Word tells us in Romans 16:9, *“And the God of peace shall bruise Satan under your feet shortly.”* So yes, as the song said, your boots are made for walking; all over the devil. I got a pair of cowboy boots for Christmas just for that purpose.

How many times have you been watching a football game and you see the running back come right through the

middle of the line and take off for a long gain. When you first see it you wonder how did he go through all those defensive linemen and just break free. Then they show the replay from different angles and you see where the offensive linemen made a big gapping hole in the defensive line. God also has some heavy-duty offensive linemen angels that can put a block on demons to give you room for your breakthrough? God is no respecter of persons. In Romans 3:4 we see, *“...let God be true, but every man a liar....”*

We need to stop looking at the world as being our provider and start looking to the kingdom of God as our provider. Take the Word and let the Word govern and provide from the inside out.

Look at Joshua 1:5. When God told Joshua to go, arise; He said, *“There shall not be any man able to stand before thee all the days of thy life: as I was with Moses, so I will be with thee.”* Now, put yourself there. Imagine God telling you that He is no respecter of persons. He was there with Moses. He was there with Joshua. And now He is here within you filled with the Holy Spirit in power and might. Joshua had a job some folks today may think was beyond impossible. He was to take the fortified city of Jericho. Some people have described the walls of Jericho as being wide enough to hold chariot races on top. Despite such formidable protection, Rahab recognized God’s greater power. In Joshua 2:10-11, she told the two spies, *“For we have heard how the Lord dried up the water of the Red Sea for you, when ye came out of Egypt; and what ye did unto the two kings of the Amorites, that were on the other side Jordan, Sihon and Og, whom ye utterly destroyed. And as soon as we*

had heard these things, our hearts did melt, neither did there remain any more courage in any man, because of you: for the Lord your God, he is God in heaven above, and in earth beneath.” You see, Israel had been wandering around in fear of an enemy that was so scared of them, that there was no “*more courage in any man....*” No wonder Joshua won all the battles. And now, this very day, your devilish enemies are afraid you will find out how strong the Lord is inside of you.

Whatever you grow inside of you is what you become. The devil does not want us to leave the world system, or to know that the kingdom of God is based on sowing and reaping. You have soil inside of you. Whatever is growing inside of you is the image of how you see things. And you don’t go any further than what you see. So before prospering on the outside, you have to prosper your soul. Prosper on the inside. It is an invisible tree that will grow up inside of you, and the fruit of that tree is the literal manifestation of what you believe for. Unlike Adam and Eve who lived in the Garden of Eden, the garden is now in us and we plant seeds of the Word of God.

We must learn to live in another reality, a kingdom of God reality. In Matthew 4:8-9, we see where the devil tried to get Jesus to live in the devil’s system. When Adam fell, he gave his authority to Satan. The devil was in a position to promise Jesus the wealth of the world if Jesus would follow him and the devil still tells people that today. But Jesus didn’t fall for it and in verse 10, Jesus spoke the Word; and then in verse 11, the devil left and angels came and ministered to Jesus. We too are called to live in the kingdom of God. We don’t wrestle with flesh and blood. People are deceived. Yet, we know from Ephesians

6:12, that our fight is against demonic principalities, not people.

In Mark 1:15, we see the “*...kingdom of God is at hand....*” We must move out from the system of the world. There is a higher way of living. We are to begin with planting the Word (Mark 4:14), “*The sower soweth the word.*” If we want to live in kingdom realities we have to sow the Word, good seed, incorruptible seed. Then it grows inside of you. An image grows of the redemption in fullness. The new image must overwrite the old distorted program that’s based on years of world teaching. Inside of you is an image, a corrupted program, based on the world teaching that is contrary to kingdom reality.

This is just as Pharaoh had programmed the children of Israel to be slaves. They didn’t want to come out of Egypt. Then when they did leave, and sent twelve spies into the promised land, ten gave what the Bible calls an evil report (Numbers 13:32). We see in verse 33 that they saw the enemy as giants and saw themselves as grasshoppers. Of course God considered that an evil report. They totally lost the proper view of being in the image and likeness of God. God is not a grasshopper. Yet, the report of the ten spies is just like too many worldly pastors today who preach what is possible with man. They look at the natural and say, well this is what is possible, nothing more. Most of us came out of that stinking teaching and we have to renew our minds to the truth, to kingdom of God realities that we are not grasshoppers in the world taking on giants; but rather we are adult mature sons and daughters in Christ’s anointing, here to not take sides, but to take over. When the kingdom arrives, it totally takes over. When Jesus went into

villages and healed them all, by the time He finished it was as though the devil had never been there. We are going into the world, into America, into America's hurt cities; and when the kingdom is released it will be as though the devil had never been there. Where there is destruction and slums; grand restoration will take place. Where the crack addicts run the streets, they will be saved, healed, delivered, and run the streets healing people in the name of Jesus.

But first, people have to hear the Word. Just like Romans 10:14-15 tells us, "*How then shall they call on him in whom they have not believed? And how shall they believe on him of whom they have not heard? And how shall they hear without a preacher? And how shall they preach, except they be sent? As it is written.*" So the preacher is to preach the true Word and people will hear the Word and believe the Word.

The ten spies only preached what was possible to the natural mind. God will often take you to a problem you can't solve, property you can not buy, and a battle you can't win; but He will give you Word seed to sow, in order that you will be able to grow that tree of faith and have the fruit of its manifestation. Put the Word seed in your heart and bridle your tongue. Do not deceive your heart by putting something in there that is different than the Word of God. The image you grow will be what you will have.

There is no limit in God. Jesus walked on water. He overcame natural laws. He had dominion over gravity and matter. But wait, Peter did too. It's not just Jesus. Our faith connects us to the spiritual realm that has authority over natural laws. We see in Matthew 13:11,

"...it is given unto you to know the mysteries of the kingdom of heaven...." We are to know another reality. We're to know how good it was in the Garden before the fall. When Adam fell, life became hard, with toil and sweat. Now, Jesus makes it possible to have sweat less victory; and God is no respecter of persons. What He does for one, He will do for you.

Jesus is our provider independently of what is happening in the world. The kingdom of God is like how you view a glacier. You only see the tip of it in the natural. The vast bulk of the glacier is like a mountain that's invisible to the natural eye. But what if you can turn that glacier upside down and pull down all sorts of resources from that reservoir. When Jesus was preaching to the 5,000, He said feed them. His disciples thought that was impossible. But with five loaves and two fishes as seed sown for the harvest, Jesus was able to feed all the people (Matthew 14:15-21). Jesus would preach and then challenge the disciples to act. Their reason would kick in, thinking it was not possible. Yet, we work out of our spirit not our mind. His anointing is on us and we need working knowledge of that anointing.

God is Jehovah Jireh, and has provided everything before the foundation of the world. It's all prepared for us. It may be in the invisible realm in the heavenlies, but we have access to it via faith given to us by God. Today in the natural as you get pay raises, the prices for everything rises, but we can live in the kingdom. In the kingdom, if you are waiting for God, you are waiting too long. Faith is now.

In Psalm 37:19 the Word says, "*They shall not be ashamed in the evil time:*

and in the days of famine they shall be satisfied.” Even in evil difficult times of great stress, the children of God are to be satisfied and live in abundance. We are to show people how to live in the kingdom of God’s system and get off the world’s system, and not be fearful of moving out of it. The world’s system is designed to keep people broke and in bondage. Most retired people can’t write a \$5,000 check and most retired people have a pension less than \$1,000 per month. Most Americans have a zero net worth because their debts equal or exceed their assets.

Yet, if we can see what others can not see then we can go where others can not go. You can sow, and then you can get from what is invisible to what is manifested. The flesh will fight us, but the church is here to feed the world and show how to operate in the kingdom of God. All of us have been made for abundance. In Matthew 6:33 we see we are to, “...*seek ye first the kingdom of God and his righteousness; and all these things shall be added to you.*” That’s the system He wants us to operate in and then to show people how it works.

We need to plant the Word seed in our heart and speak it aloud with our mouth. Many people think they are talking the truth when in reality they are only speaking current facts. That is not the same as speaking the Word of truth. The Holy Spirit increases the Word seed in our heart and develops a full-blown image. We can go no further than the image in us. When the ten spies brought back an evil report to the people, their unbelief was contagious and God could not take them to the Promised Land. They died off without fulfilling their destiny. God had to wait for a new generation, the Joshua generation.

Similarly, your unbelief can stop God from taking you to your destiny.

There was research done with Piranha fish. Piranhas are very aggressive and eat anything with flesh. The researchers divided the holding tank with a piece of clear plastic and had Piranha on one side and other fish on the other side. They kept the divider in the tank for 30 days, and then removed it. Even after they removed the divider keeping the Piranha from the other fish, the Piranha didn’t go after the other fish. They no longer believed the other fish were accessible. Similarly, people have built invisible walls and fences within them that keep them from going further. We have to reset those boundaries resulting from past failures, and what we were led to expect of ourselves from family, friends, coworkers, etc. What we believe affects our decisions and affects our boundaries.

Your prosperity and success is God based and He already made extravagant provisions for you. Now you have to meditate on the Word and reset your internal boundaries. In Matthew 6:10, we see, “*Thy kingdom come. Thy will be done in earth, as it is in heaven.*” This is critical. First, we see that the kingdom has to be in place first. That’s where the power is. And praise God we know from Mark 1:15, “...*the kingdom of God is at hand....*” So the kingdom is here now. Then going back to Matthew 6:10, knowing the kingdom is here; we also know God’s will is for earth to be like heaven. You don’t have to wait to go to heaven. It’s in you now and the manifestation of that reality is God’s will. He said the Father’s will be done in earth as it is in heaven. Then in verse 13 we see it’s not His will that we fall into temptation, but rather that we be delivered from evil. Furthermore, in

verses 19-20 we see direction to not lay up treasures in earth, but rather treasures in heaven because they can not be corrupted or destroyed. Great insight is gained in verse 21, "*For where your treasure is, there will your heart be also.*" You see there are two systems; the world's system and God's system. Jesus is teaching that your heart follows where your treasure is. Which system do you trust, the world's or God's?

When Peter was fishing he caught nothing. Now, Jesus was preaching and asked to use Peter's boat. Peter consented and Jesus used the boat to teach. Afterwards, Jesus commanded Peter to cast out his nets. Peter complained that he had already toiled and caught nothing. But after obeying Jesus, Peter caught a huge amount of fish. Jesus must have taught increase because the faith comes through the spoken Word. If you want to see healings, preach healing scriptures, etc. Peter then switched systems. When Peter tried the world's system he caught nothing. When Peter sowed the boat to Jesus, Peter's seed (the boat) brought a huge harvest of fish that Peter reaped. (Luke 5:1-7)

God provides seed to the sower (2 Corinthians 9:10). Jesus moved Peter from the buy and sell system to the sowing and reaping system. Real increase comes from what you sow, not what you sell.

Matthew 6:22-23 tells us, "*The light of the body is the eye: if therefore thine eye be single, thy whole body shall be full of light. But if thine eye be evil, thy whole body shall be full of darkness....*" We can receive illumination from God that we get no other way. Through the light comes revelation and we can see what

others can not see. However, we can not mix both systems. We have to jump into the light and stay there. If you mix clear and muddy water together you still have muddy water. Only with being single minded in kingdom of God realities do you get illumination and revelation from God. In 2 Corinthians 4:18, we're told to "*...look not at the things which are seen, but at the things which are not seen: for the things which are seen are temporal; but the things which are not seen are eternal.*"

Then in Matthew 6:24 we see, "*No man can serve two masters: for either he will hate the one, and love the other; or he will hold to one, and despise the other. Ye cannot serve God and mammon.* You just can't serve God and man.

As a man, "*...thinketh in his heart, so is he....*" (Proverbs 23:7) We sow God's incorruptible seed into our heart and that sown seed reaps back a hundred fold in this time. We are able to abound to any good work because there is more than enough for what God calls us to do.

The kingdom of God is at hand and we are going to live in kingdom realities now! The reclaiming of America starts with God reclaiming us from the world. We need to be free in Christ before we can free America from the world.
