A Time for God to Reign in America. Part 1

So, just how in the world is America Reclaimed Ministries (ARM) going to reclaim America when all around us we see crass barbarism? Actually, we are not going to do it "in the world". What a sigh of relief that is. ARM will; however, glorify God through the reclaiming of America using Biblical principles and truths, and through the demonstration of God's love and compassion. It will be a very quick work of God. Some will say no way. That is fine, we don't mind what some people say or think because Jesus says, "...I am the way...." These are powerful words. I have seen these four short words immediately heal incurable cancer. These four short words are more powerful than all the demons of hell combined. Nothing and no one can stop the true and living Word of God. It is the ultimate truth to which everything else must conform. When the glory of

God is at hand, every problem, every sickness, every curse, every sin is overcome; and, yes, even a Nation just stands in awe. Oh how great is our Lord to forgive and revive America.

We read in Matthew 6:9-13, "*After this manner therefore pray ye: Our Father which art in heaven, Hallowed be thy name. Thy kingdom come, Thy will be done in earth, as it is in heaven. Give us this day our daily bread. And forgive us our debts, as we forgive our debtors. And lead us not into temptation, but deliver us from evil: For thine is the kingdom, and the power, and the glory, for ever. Amen.*"

Then moving to verses 25-33, we read, "*Therefore I say unto you, Take no thought for your life, what ye shall eat, or what ye shall drink; nor yet for your body, what ye shall put on. Is not the life more than meat, and the body than raiment? Behold the fowls of the air: for they sow not, neither do they reap, nor gather into barns; yet your heavenly Father feedeth them. Are ye not much better than they? Which of you by taking thought can add one cubit unto his*

stature? And why take ye thought for raiment? Consider the lilies of the field, how they grow; they toil not, neither do they spin: And yet I say unto you, That even Solomon in all his glory was not arrayed like one of these. Wherefore, if God so clothe the grass of the field, which to day is, and to morrow is cast into the oven, shall he not much more clothe you, O ye of little faith? Therefore take no thought, saying, What shall we eat? or, What shall we drink? or, Wherewithal shall we be clothed? (For after all these things do the Gentiles seek:) for your heavenly Father knoweth that ye have need of all these things. But seek ye first the kingdom of God, and his righteousness; and all these things shall be added unto you.”

We will always be victorious when under God’s authority and not our own. It is God’s battle, not ours. Is anything too hard for God? Of course not. So we are talking about things happening supernaturally. People are waiting for us to prove who God is by demonstration. There is a power that comes with the Gospel. Paul wrote in 1 Corinthians 2:4, “*And my speech and my preaching was not with enticing words of man’s wisdom, but in demonstration of the Spirit and of power.*”

I will always look back at the first introduction Bobbie and I had to a church moving in the supernatural ability of God. I had been in a very low point in my life with intense financial distress when a Christian friend invited Bobbie and I to their church. The place was alive during praise and worship with people crying and even occasionally screaming with joy and excitement. This was very distressing initially to my sedate Baptist upbringing. However, we

began to see miracle after miracle, especially on Sunday evenings when the Pastor taught the Word with emphasis on healing. It was the most amazing thing of my life to see the power of God instantly heal people who had been bound with birth defects and all manner of diseases and infirmities for years. I learned that the emotion during the praise and worship was a heartfelt total thanksgiving to God for the mighty works He was doing. The people did not care what anyone thought, as they were literally experiencing Jesus first hand. What more could anyone want?

I came to learn that once we enter into the kingdom of God, we are living on a higher plane; a higher plane of knowledge, a higher plane of joy, a higher plane of living in every area. So, we have to realize that we were made for signs and wonders. Isaiah 8:18, “*Behold, I and the children whom the LORD hath given me are for signs and wonders....”* **It is these signs and wonders of God’s glory that will heal America.**

If we go back to Genesis, we can see our roots. Genesis 1:1-5, we read, “*In the beginning God created the heaven and the earth. And the earth was without form, and void; and darkness was upon the face of the deep. And the Spirit of God moved upon the face of the waters. And God said, Let there be light: and there was light. And God saw the light, that it was good: and God divided the light from the darkness. And God called the light Day, and the darkness he called Night. And the evening and the morning were the first day.*” We see here where God made the earth, and made day and night and we call that one day. God placed time in this earth for a reason.

In Genesis 1:26-27, we see, “*And God said, Let us make man in our image, after our likeness: and let them have dominion over the fish of the sea, and over the fowl of the air, and over the cattle, and over all the earth, and over every creeping thing that creepeth upon the earth. So God created man in his own image, in the image of God created he him; male and female created he them.*” So we see God created a class of beings, human beings, in His own image and likeness, to be like God. Not that man is sovereign because he is totally dependent upon God, but man is to reign on behalf of God on the earth. When God wanted the world and man in a certain order He spoke to them and they became as God commanded. What God said, became reality. We too are to, “*...look not at the things which are seen, but at the things which are not seen: for the things which are seen are temporal; but the things which are not seen are eternal.*” (2 Corinthians 4:18)

In Genesis 2:7 we also learn, “*And the Lord God formed man of the dust of the ground, and breathed into his nostrils, the breath of life, and man became a living soul.*” So, God created man before He formed man. Man’s spirit was created on the sixth day, but his body was formed afterwards. The true core of who you are is a spirit man created by God, and you live in a body and have a mind. Back in 1993, I wrote a short book on this subject, “The First Side of Man.”

In the spirit, things are timeless. In 2 Peter 3:8-9 we learn, “*But, beloved, be not ignorant of this one thing, that one day is with the Lord as a thousand years, and a thousand years as one day. The Lord is not slack concerning his*

promise, as some men count slackness; but is longsuffering to us-ward, not willing that any should perish, but that all should come to repentance.” Here we see some attributes of the Lord and in verse eight we see that one of them is that one day is as a thousand years and a thousand years is as one day. He said one day with the Lord is as a thousand years. You could say one day with the Lord is like a thousand years, and a thousand years with the Lord is like one day.

Additionally, Ephesians 1:3 says, “*Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, who hath blessed us with all spiritual blessings in heavenly places in Christ:*” Notice that He has already blessed us; it is not something He is going to do. As we look at the next verse we see, “*According as he hath chosen us in him before the foundation of the world, that we should be holy and without blame before him in love.*” Notice it says “according.” When you see the word “according,” it means according to something. It connects something. That something is **His spiritual blessing that was upon us before the foundation of the world.** God chose you and me to be with Him before the foundation of the world. So, when were you chosen? Before the foundation of the world. When did God bless you? Before the foundation of the world. When did God provide everything you need? Before the foundation of the world. When did God provide your healing? Before the foundation of the world. When did God provide for the restoration of America? Before the foundation of the world. He has done it all. The rest it up to the receiver.

Going back to 2 Peter 1:2, “*Grace and peace be multiplied unto you through the knowledge of God, and of Jesus our Lord,*” What kind of knowledge is that? It is not intellectual knowledge from a text book. It is revelational knowledge to your spirit. We are not talking about something you reason out, but rather a higher kind of knowledge. As we read in verses 3 and 4 we see, “*According as his divine power hath given unto us all things that pertain unto life and godliness, through the knowledge of him that hath called us to glory and virtue: Whereby are given unto us exceeding great and precious promises: that by these ye might be partakers of the divine nature, having escaped the corruption that is in the world through lust.*” Note, it is not that God is going to give us something. He already has given us all things that pertain to life and godliness, through the knowledge of Him (again referring to revelational knowledge). We have already been given exceedingly great and precious promises that we may be partakers of the divine nature. Hello, we are not talking carnal here, but rather referring to our position in the image and likeness of God.

Going back to Genesis, look in Chapter 2, verses 15-17. “*And the LORD God took the man, and put him into the garden of Eden to dress it and to keep it. And the LORD God commanded the man, saying, Of every tree of the garden thou mayest freely eat: But of the tree of the knowledge of good and evil, thou shalt not eat of it: for in the day that thou eatest thereof thou shalt surely die.*” Notice that God told Adam that if he ate of the tree of the knowledge of good and evil, that he would die. God had to say that, because as of that time, Adam was created and formed to live

forever. If death was already in the program God wouldn’t have had to say that. Then in verse 18-20, we read, “*And the LORD God said, It is not good that the man should be alone; I will make him an help meet for him. And out of the ground the LORD God formed every beast of the field, and every fowl of the air; and brought them unto Adam to see what he would call them: and whatsoever Adam called every living creature, that was the name thereof. And Adam gave names to all cattle, and to the fowl of the air, and to every beast of the field; but for Adam there was not found an help meet for him.*” Who named the animals and birds? Adam. Adam was functioning like God and he and God were not two, but in total communion together operating as one. If I separate a plant from the soil, it dies. If I separate a fish from water it dies. God told Adam that if he separated himself from God by eating of the tree, he would die. Realize that Adam had no formal schooling and everything he knew came through revelational knowledge from God. Adam received everything he needed from God.

In John 14:16 we see Jesus say, “*And I will pray the Father, and he shall give you another Comforter, that he may abide with you forever.*” Here Jesus is saying He was going away, but the Father would be sending the Holy Spirit to abide with us. Now as we look at the next verse, “*Even the Spirit of truth, whom the world cannot receive, because it seeth him not, neither knoweth him: but ye know him; for he dwelleth with you, and shall be in you.*” Truly the world does not know God, but for you and me He (in timelessness) dwells within us. We relate to Him spirit to Spirit. Then, as we look at verse 26 we

see, *“But the Comforter, which is the Holy Ghost, whom the Father will send in my name, he shall teach you all things, and bring all things to your remembrance, whatsoever I have said to you.”* So the Holy Spirit is a teacher and is going to teach us all things, and He also is going to bring things to our remembrance. We will have access to the things God said in the past. We are going to remember the Word and have it in our spirit at the needed moment. That Word, that spoken Word will not come back void, but will accomplish what it is sent to do. (Isaiah 55:11) Then in John 16:13 we see, *“Howbeit when he, the Spirit of truth is come, he will guide you into all truth: for he shall not speak of himself; but whatsoever he shall hear, that shall he speak: and he will show you things to come.”* So the Holy Spirit is going to reveal the will of God and show us things to come. **The Holy Spirit reveals God’s strategy for reclaiming America. The Holy Spirit reveals to us His vision for America. We are not building our vision but His vision.** We not only have remembrance of what God promised us in the past, but God also shows us things to come.

In Matthew 13:10-11 we see, *“And the disciples came, and said unto him, Why speakest thou unto them in parables? He answered and said unto them, Because it is given unto you to know the mysteries of the kingdom of heaven, but to them it is not given.”* So we learn here that we are going to perceive things that are not being given to those that are not in the kingdom. **Have you wondered why the mass media seems so unaware of such spiritual realities as they report the news? They do not have this understanding. It is simply the world reporting on current**

conditions with absolutely no revelation of God’s view. I am not criticizing these people, I am just saying they do not have the revelation that really matters. They are clueless as to how events today fit into the future plan of God.

In 1 Corinthians 2:4-5, Paul says, *“And my speech and my teaching was not with enticing words of man’s wisdom, but in demonstration of the Spirit and of power. That your faith shall not stand in the wisdom of men, but in the power of God.”* **Paul was a brilliant man, but he gave up sense knowledge for revelation knowledge because revelation knowledge is above sense knowledge.** Reading on in verses 6-8 we see, *“Howbeit we speak with wisdom among them that are perfect: yet not the wisdom of this world, nor of the princes of this world, that come to nought: But we speak the wisdom of God in a mystery, even the hidden wisdom, which God ordained before the world unto our glory: Which none of the princes of this world knew: for had they known it, they would not have crucified the Lord of glory.”* We see that the princes of the world did not have the hidden wisdom of God and if they did, they would not have crucified the Lord. **We, however, are given the wisdom of God that is a mystery to the world.** Paul gave up sense knowledge and lived in revelation knowledge, which took him above the things of the devil and the world.

You cannot take dominion in this world over Satan without revelation. The wisdom of man comes from what you can figure out with your mind and reason. But that is far below how God desires for you to live. Satan has an entire system hooked up on sense

knowledge. The whole system around you is fear based. The enemy pervades the environment with things that speak to your mind. Movies show some evil monster coming in and killing everything. The enemy wants to project an image that things in this earth have dominion over you. If he can produce shortage in your mind, then that is what you will have. Satan is bound in time and that is why he teaches people to talk in time. Paul teaches to be transformed by the renewing of your mind.

In Romans 4:17 we learn, *“(As it is written, I have made thee a father of many nations,) before him whom he believed, even God, who quickeneth the dead, and calleth those things which be not as though they were.”* God calls things that be not as though they are. In Genesis 17:5, God told Abram, *“Neither shall thy name any more be called Abram, but thy name shall be Abraham; a father of many nations have I made thee.”* So, He calls things not as though they are. He did not tell Abram that He was going to make him a father of many nations. God changed Abram’s name to Abraham right then. God said, *“...a father of many nations have I made thee.”* You see, it was a done deal. God did not have to wait on time. You can not say I am going to be healed, and expect healing now. “I am going to be healed” is not in the Bible. Faith is now.

God is now. There is no time in God and we are to operate in God. 1 Peter 2:23 says, *“...by whose stripes ye were healed.”* It is already done. Do not put it in the future. That is what the devil wants to do to limit you, and to limit our reclaiming of America. But, that is not God’s perception. Meditate on what your life would be like perceiving things how God perceives them. When we were in Colorado, our Pastor often prayed that he and we would see things the way God sees them. Wow, that really opens your spiritual eyes! Imagine seeing issues the way God sees them. **Imagine seeing solutions the way God sees them.** God is waiting for us to get that revelation knowledge to live that way every moment.

There are two kinds of faith, man’s and God’s. Man’s faith says I will believe it when I see it. He asks for a sign. No answers can come when sought for in that kind of faith. God kind of faith is the expectation that God will deliver based on His word. It knows that it is done because God said it.

America has been made to glorify God and advance the Christian faith. America is the lighthouse to the world of God’s loving, passion to save mankind. America’s destiny, and your destiny, was established before the foundation of the world.
