A Time for God to Reign in America. Part 2

In Part 1 we learned that we were made for signs and wonders (Isaiah 8:18) and that these signs and wonders of God's glory will heal America. Additionally we saw that God blessed us with all spiritual blessings and chose us in Him before the foundation of the world (Ephesians 1:3-4). We also discussed how the Spirit of truth guides us in all truth (John 16:13) and that the Holy Spirit reveals God's strategy for reclaiming America and His vision for America.

In Romans 4:19-21 it says of Abraham: *"And being not weak in faith, he considered not his own body now dead, when he was about an hundred years old, neither yet the deadness of Sarah's womb: He staggered not at the promise of God through unbelief; but was strong in faith, giving glory to God; And being fully persuaded that, what he had promised, he was able also to perform."* Abraham believed. He didn't stagger at the promise of God, and being fully persuaded, he also performed. Abraham said what God said. We too must speak God's Word over America. Our words have power and we must bless America with our God-given words.

In Mark 11:13-14 it says, *"And seeing a fig tree afar off having leaves, he came, if haply he might find any thing thereon: and when he came to it, he found nothing but leaves; for the time of figs was not yet. And Jesus answered and said unto it, No man eat fruit of thee hereafter for ever. And his disciples heard it."* Jesus spoke to the tree and his disciples heard it. Jesus subjected

himself to ridicule in calling things that be not as though they were. Similarly, when Jesus went into Jairus' house, he once again subjected himself to ridicule and scorn, by not agreeing with everyone that Jairus' daughter was dead. He spoke what he perceived the Father told him to say, *"Why make ye this ado, and weep? The damsel is not dead, but sleepeth."* (Mark 5:39)

We must show people that the same Lord who lived 2,000 years ago is still alive today. Going back to the fig tree, we know from Mark 11:20-22, *"And in the morning, as they passed by, they saw the fig tree dried up from the roots. And Peter calling to remembrance saith unto him, Master, behold, the fig tree which thou cursedst is withered away. And Jesus answering saith unto them, Have faith in God."* So we are to have faith in God, or a God kind of faith. Then Jesus goes on to describe God's kind of faith. *"For verily I say unto you, That whosoever shall say unto this mountain, Be thou removed, and be thou cast into the sea; and shall not doubt in his heart, but shall believe that those things which he saith shall come to pass; he shall have whatsoever he saith. Therefore I say unto you, What things soever ye desire, when ye pray, believe that ye receive them, and ye shall have them."* (Mark 11:23-24) Jesus said when you pray, believe that you receive. It's a now event. Jesus rebuked the fig tree and the next morning Peter noted the fig tree was dried up by the roots. Peter was miracle minded. Peter was also the one who walked on water. Be miracle minded.

Don't be trapped in time and pray for your miracle to happen in the distant future. Get rid of fear and get back into

faith to access the timeless things of God, and you will be able to walk in victory over the pressures of the world.

In the presence of God, all time and space limitations go away. You are seated with Christ at the right hand of the Father. You have to renew your mind. The enemy has trained you to live in the constraints of time, that someday your miracle will come, someday your finances will come, but not now. Hogwash! You can receive it right now. We can lay hands on the sick in Jesus name, and the faith in that name can transfer a kidney from the heavenly right now. Don't think it's going to take six weeks for a broken arm to heal. You can reach into the kingdom of God and have that arm healed right now.

In John 2:1-5 we see, *“And the third day there was a marriage in Cana of Galilee; and the mother of Jesus was there: And both Jesus was called, and his disciples, to the marriage. And when they wanted wine, the mother of Jesus saith unto him, They have no wine. Jesus saith unto her, Woman, what have I to do with thee? mine hour is not yet come. His mother saith unto the servants, Whatsoever he saith unto you, do it.”* Do you see what faith is? You just do what Jesus tells you when He tells you. It's now. We've been listening to the world on how things should be, but we have access to the timeless wisdom of God that the world doesn't have. We should know how to pay off a debt within seven days. Our businesses should be producing millions of dollars a year, right now. Going back to John, we read in verses 6-11, *“And there were set there six waterpots of stone, after the manner of the purifying of the Jews, containing two or three*

firkins apiece. Jesus saith unto them, Fill the waterpots with water. And they filled them up to the brim. And he saith unto them, Draw out now, and bear unto the governor of the feast. And they bare it. When the ruler of the feast had tasted the water that was made wine, and knew not whence it was: (but the servants which drew the water knew;) the governor of the feast called the bridegroom, And saith unto him, Every man at the beginning doth set forth good wine; and when men have well drunk, then that which is worse: but thou hast kept the good wine until now. This beginning of miracles did Jesus in Cana of Galilee, and manifested forth his glory; and his disciples believed on him.” So what happened? How do you prepare wine? You plant seeds, grow the vines, wait six years to have a harvest, pick the grapes, smash the grapes, put it through a process, put it in a bottle, and then you finally have wine ready to drink. Jesus went from the beginning to the final product instantly. He overrode time.

A key to miracles is to understand time. Your mind has been programmed to wait. But look at how Jesus operated. It was immediate. God is going to restore that which was stolen from you. In Amos 9:13, we see, *“Behold the days come, saith the Lord, that the plowman shall overtake the reaper, and the treader of grapes him that soweth seed....”* The essence of time lies in the secret of His presence. In Hebrews 11:5 we see the reference to Enoch. One day he was just gone. *“By faith Enoch was translated that he should not see death: and was not found, because God translated him.”* He was in God's presence to such a degree that he just

stepped over from the physical realm to the heavenly.

When we are talking about living a kingdom life, we're talking about living on a different level above the fallen state of mankind. Adam operated on a higher level when he was connected and communicated directly with God. Once mankind sinned in the garden, Adam and Eve lost that relationship. Their spirit died, that candle of the Lord that God used to lead Adam. Mankind became alienated from God. God then had to restore the relationship with man and He did that through Jesus Christ. Through a new covenant God made with us, we can accept Jesus as Lord and Savior and become born again. Once a person is born again they are born into the family of God. Then God prepares and trains them. The first thing God wants to do is to fill them with the Holy Spirit. Some people stop at salvation, but in the Bible, people went to the next level and received the fullness of the Holy Spirit as evidenced by speaking with other tongues. That assists us to walk in the fullness of God's power and spiritual discernment as the Lord leads us along His path.

The supernatural is man's natural world. It is what we have been designed for. The Bible says, "...*the just shall live by faith.*" (Romans 1:17) We operate at a level we can't physically see. Most people are living far beneath their privileges; and for God to get through to them He's going to have to do it from the outside, because they won't hear Him from the inside. In 1 Corinthians 3:1, we see Paul saying, "*And I, brethren, could not speak unto you as unto spiritual, but as unto carnal, even as unto babes in Christ.*" Paul is saying

he couldn't speak to them from a deep spiritual understanding, from spirit to spirit, but rather he had to speak to them in their carnality. When God spoke to Adam it was Spirit to spirit before the fall. Today, we should be living on that same level with God. We should be hearing on the inside what God is saying, rather than looking for external signs. God wants to speak to us Spirit to spirit. Paul goes on to say, "*I have fed you with milk, and not with meat: for hitherto ye were not able to bear it, neither yet now are ye able. For ye are yet carnal: for whereas there is among you envying, and strife, and divisions, are ye not carnal, and walk as men?*" (1 Corinthians 3:2-3) The Amplified Bible says "mere" men. So we are not to walk as mere men, but on a much higher level in the kingdom of God. People are not experiencing it because they are walking carnally.

In Romans 8:5-6 we see, "*For they that are after the flesh do mind the things of the flesh: but they that are after the Spirit the things of the Spirit. For to be carnally minded is death; but to be spiritually minded is life and peace.*" Notice it says that to be carnally minded is death. That is the realm of the enemy, and the devil will do everything he can to keep you operating in his realm. But, we are called to operate high above that level where there is life and peace. There is no death in heaven so why are Christians wallowing around carnally minded in death? We have been so immersed by our senses and the world around us we have been transformed to it, rather than living on a level with God, and transforming the world.

If the devil can keep you in the flesh, he can keep you controlled. You are not

healed when you feel like it. That is carnal and death. In verses 7-8 we see, *“Because the carnal mind is enmity against God: for it is not subject to the law of God, neither indeed can be. So then they that are in the flesh cannot please God.”* In the early church, miracles were everyday occurrences. Why isn't that happening globally today? The traditions of men have denied the miraculous of God.

In John 6:1-2, we see, *“After these things Jesus went over the sea of Galilee, which is the sea of Tiberias. And a great multitude followed him, because they saw his miracles which he did on them that were diseased.”* The people followed Jesus because they saw the external evidence of a miraculous God. The people were drawn by the miraculous because mankind was designed to hunger for the supernatural.

But note what miracles do. They talk to man from the outside in. Carnal man needs something physical to know if its true. In Mark 16:14, we read, *“Afterward he appeared unto the eleven as they sat at meat, and upbraided them with their unbelief and hardness of heart, because they believed not them which had seen him after he was risen.”* We have to realize there are two kinds of faith; man's kind of faith, and God's kind of faith. The God kind of faith believes the things that are said shall come to pass. The man kind of faith has to see it and feel it to believe something is true. We see examples in the Bible from the 10 spies who gave an evil report contrasted with the two spies who said, let's go take our land. We can see it when Jesus said Jairus' daughter is sleeping. The God kind of faith takes

God's word and counts it as true and believes it.

As we continue in Mark, we see in verses 15-20, *“And he said unto them, Go ye into all the world, and preach the gospel to every creature. He that believeth and is baptized shall be saved; but he that believeth not shall be damned. And these signs shall follow them that believe; In my name shall they cast out devils; they shall speak with new tongues; They shall take up serpents; and if they drink any deadly thing, it shall not hurt them; they shall lay hands on the sick, and they shall recover. So then after the Lord had spoken unto them, he was received up into heaven, and sat on the right hand of God. And they went forth, and preached every where, the Lord working with them, and confirming the word with signs following. Amen.”* This is the Word. Are we believing it and living it? Notice in verse 20, the Lord works with them confirming the word with signs following. The Lord isn't confirming any ministry or person, but rather confirming the Word. Notice also that signs follow. You are not supposed to follow signs. Signs and wonders are supposed to follow you. Time, space, and matter are all subject to God. In God, there is no time. So we can access a timeless consciousness by faith. Faith transcends time and transfers everything that's been put aside for us from before the foundation of the world into the here and now. Faith brings us into the timeless zone and faith sees what is available right now!

In Numbers 17:6-8, we read, *“And Moses spake unto the children of Israel, and every one of their princes gave him a rod apiece, for each prince one,*

according to their fathers' houses, even twelve rods: and the rod of Aaron was among their rods. And Moses laid up the rods before the LORD in the tabernacle of witness. And it came to pass, that on the morrow Moses went into the tabernacle of witness; and, behold, the rod of Aaron for the house of Levi was budded, and brought forth buds, and bloomed blossoms, and yielded almonds." Notice how long it took for the rods or sticks to bud, bloom, blossom, and yield almonds. In one day, the rod of Aaron for the house of Levi was budded, bloomed, blossomed, and yielded almonds. God overrode time. We are called to a faith that supersedes and overrides time. With God, everything is NOW. Stop drifting into a time consciousness because you are not there anymore. That's not the miracle realm.

This is the spiritual maturity and wisdom it will take to reclaim our great nation. As we learn to hear and obey the spoken Word of God we have faith that America will be healed. Her best days are ahead of her and not very far away. God Bless America!
